What is Community Safety?

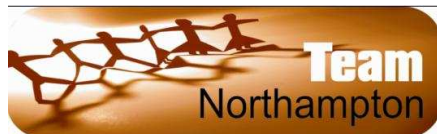
"Community safety means preventing, reducing or containing the social, environmental and intimidatory factors which affect people's right to live without fear of crime and which impact upon their quality of life. It includes preventative measures that contribute to crime reduction and tackling anti-social behaviour."

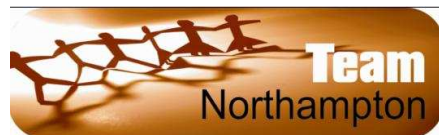

Partnership Structure





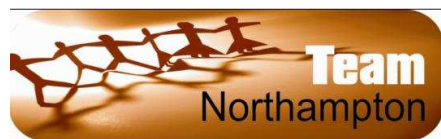

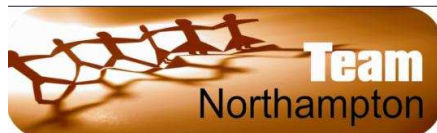

What is Hate Crime?

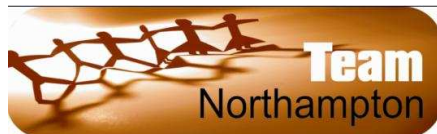
- Hate Crime – Any Crime that is **perceived** by **anyone** to be motivated by hatred or prejudice against someone's race, religion, gender identity, sexuality or disability
- Hate Incident - Any Incident that is **perceived** by **anyone** to be motivated by hatred or prejudice against someone's race, religion, gender identity, sexuality or disability





Why do we have a Policy?

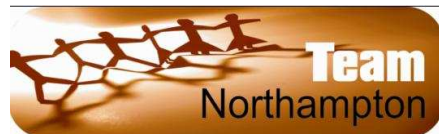

Aims of policy and procedures

- To provide a supportive service to customers and members of the public who experience a hate crime/incident
- To support employees who experience a hate incident/crime that involves customers, members of the public or another employee
- To identify and deal appropriately with alleged perpetrators
- To support the collection and reporting of statistics relating to hate crime/incidents experienced by customers and members of the public in general so that action can be taken to prevent it happening again
