As the newly appointed Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee I am very much looking forward to leading Overview and Scrutiny and I am eager to promote the good work of Overview and Scrutiny wider.

I acknowledge the good work undertaken by Overview and Scrutiny at Northampton to date and I am pleased to note that a number of our Scrutiny Reviews and Policies have been noted externally as examples of best practice.

Overview and Scrutiny is a key part of the Council's governance arrangements. It is responsible for holding the Cabinet to account. It helps to develop policy, looking at improving performance and dealing with other issues - not just those related to Council services, but also those of partner agencies - all with the aim of improving services for local people. Overview and Scrutiny perform this latter role through the in depth Scrutiny Reviews, speaking with expert witnesses and making recommendations about how Services can be improved.

We asked the citizens of Northampton to suggest topics for Scrutiny Reviews. We were really pleased that over thirty suggestions were put forward which were considered at the annual Work Shop event on 6th June 2011. From these suggestions, Cabinet's priorities for the year and suggestions put forward by individual non-Executives, the Overview and Scrutiny Committee approved its work programme for the year at its recent meeting (detailed below). I look forward to keeping you updated on progress.

I hope that you find this newsletter useful and informative. Overview and Scrutiny encourages members of the public, groups and organisations to attend its Committee and Panel meetings. Dates of forthcoming meetings are detailed on the last page of this newsletter.

How are Scrutiny Reviews carried out?

Scrutiny Panel Reviews are selected from issues which the Overview and Scrutiny Committee considers important to the people of Northampton. Scrutiny Panels are led by non-Executive Councillors.

Often individuals and representatives of organisations, who have expertise or have expressed an interest in a particular subject, are co-opted to the Scrutiny Panel for the life of the Review.

Scrutiny Panels are responsible for managing each Review by gathering and taking evidence. At the end of the Review they present their findings to the Overview and Scrutiny Committee for approval.

Scrutiny Activity for 2011/2012

The Overview and Scrutiny work programme for 2011/2012 was recently approved and the three in-depth Reviews that are now underway are: -

- Hate Crime
 To review the approach to dealing with Hate Crime
- Independent Living Strategy
 To evaluate the draft Independent Living Strategy for older people and make recommendations for development of this Strategy
- Councillor Empowerment Fund
 To review the effectiveness of a Councillor
 Empowerment Fund
